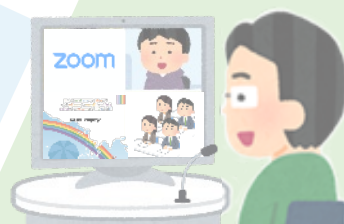

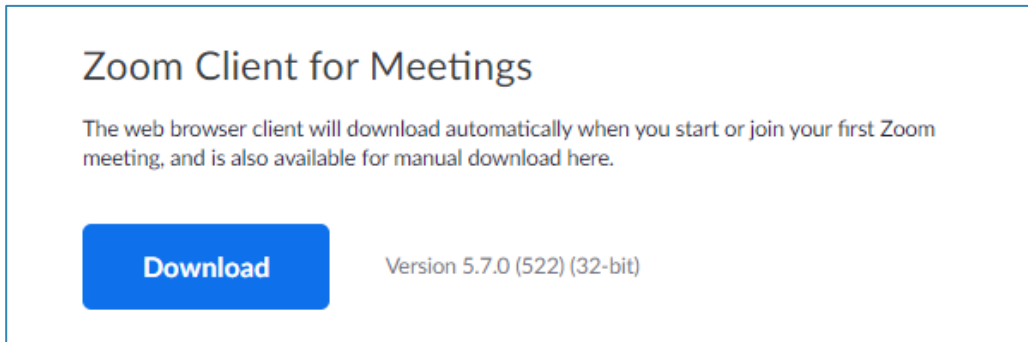

① Download Zoom Client for Meetings

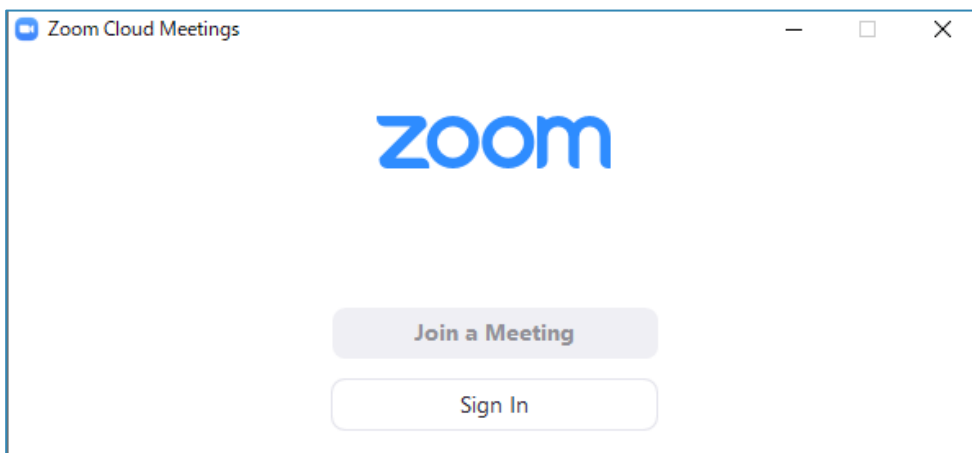

1-3. Basic Operation of Zoom Webinar

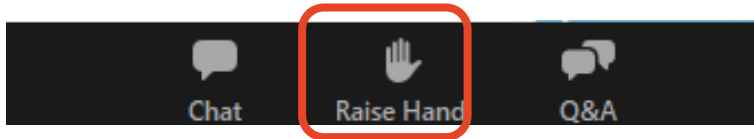


- ① **Audio Settings** : Change speakers
- ② **Chat** : Please do not use this feature
- ③ **Raise Hand** : Click on it when you ask a question with your voice
- ④ **Q&A** : Type a question
- ⑤ **Leave** : Leave the zoom webinar

1-4. Ask Questions with your Voice

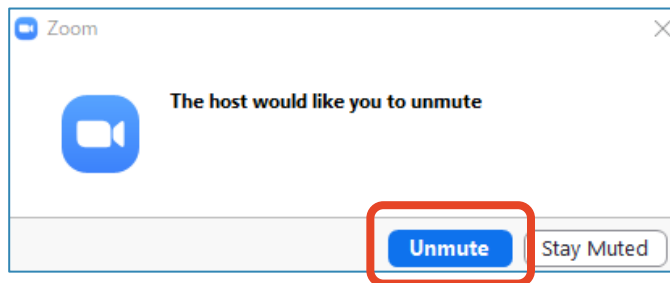
① Click on “Raise Hand”

Click on the button “Raise Hand” from the menu bar to get a chair’s attention.

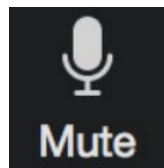


② Unmute and speak when you are chosen

When a chair chose you to ask a question, click on “Unmute” to turn on your microphone and speak.



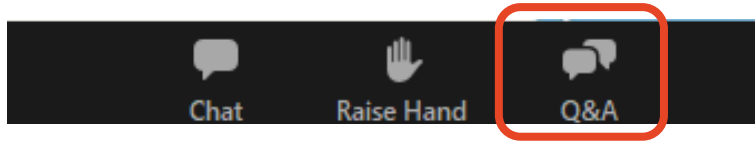
*The tab below on the menu bar shows you are unmuted.



③ Mute yourself after you finished speaking

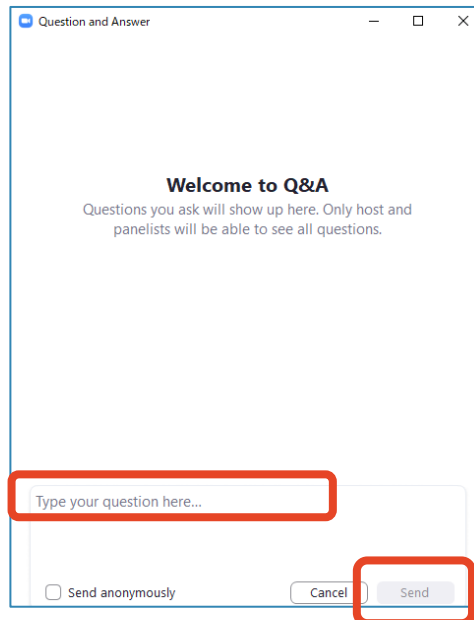
1-4. Ask Questions via Text

Input your question in the area “Type your question here...” and Click on the “Send” button.

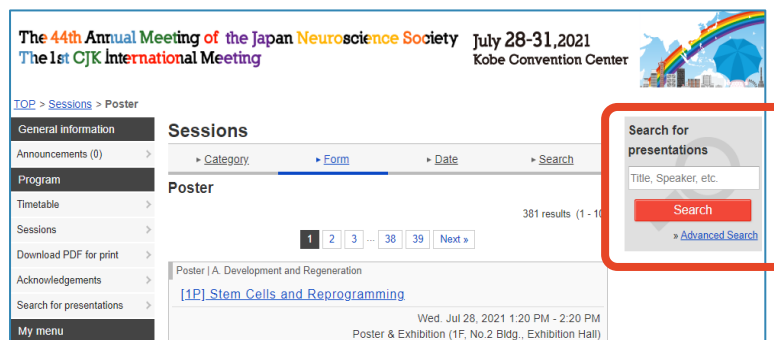

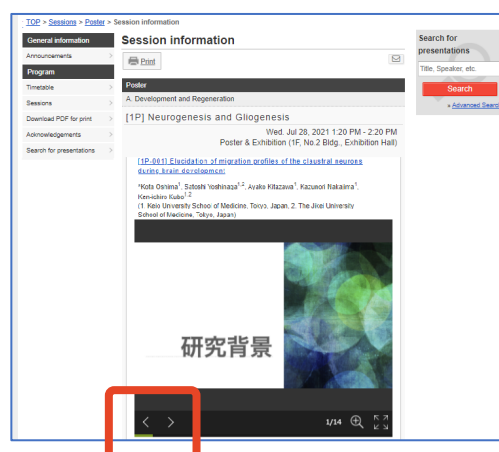


② Access the abstract page
